Illinois American Coed Pageants and American Coed Pageants shall have no liability in regard to such grants or scholarships either as to amounts or performance. Contestant must never have been married or have a child. The state winner will be asked to sign a contract for the year of her reign, which spells out awards and prizes won, as well as responsibilities of the winner. If the state winner does not sign the contract, she will forfeit her state title, all prizes and cash awards. It is understood that sponsor fees and all other fees are non-refundable without exception.
